It's great to meet you! You're reading this because you saw or experienced something that isn't okay. Remember, you did nothing wrong, but there are some people that need to hear your story so they can understand what happened and help you. Now, it's time to go on your Big Brave Journey so you can meet them, but first, this booklet has lots of answers to many questions you might have, as well as lots of fun games and activities to do!

What is a Big Brave Journey?

Your Big Brave Journey is like a special road trip – but with this trip, it's all about telling your story, meeting people who will help you, and going to new places as part of the court process. You will need to bring patience, courage, trust and truth.

Who will I meet?

You will meet lots of different people on your Big Brave Journey. Just remember that they're here to support you so you can finish your whole journey – some people you will see more than others, like your PACT Support Person.

Where will we go?

Just like a road trip, you will stop at new places. You won't be at each place for long and you can think of them all as your safe spaces. You might see a police station, a court, and a special safe video room where you can talk to a judge through a TV!

How long will it take?

It can take a long time, but like any journey, it will have an end. The first thing you will do is talk with Platy Police, then you will meet your PACT Support Person. After you go to court to give evidence, you will be closer to the finish line of your brave journey!

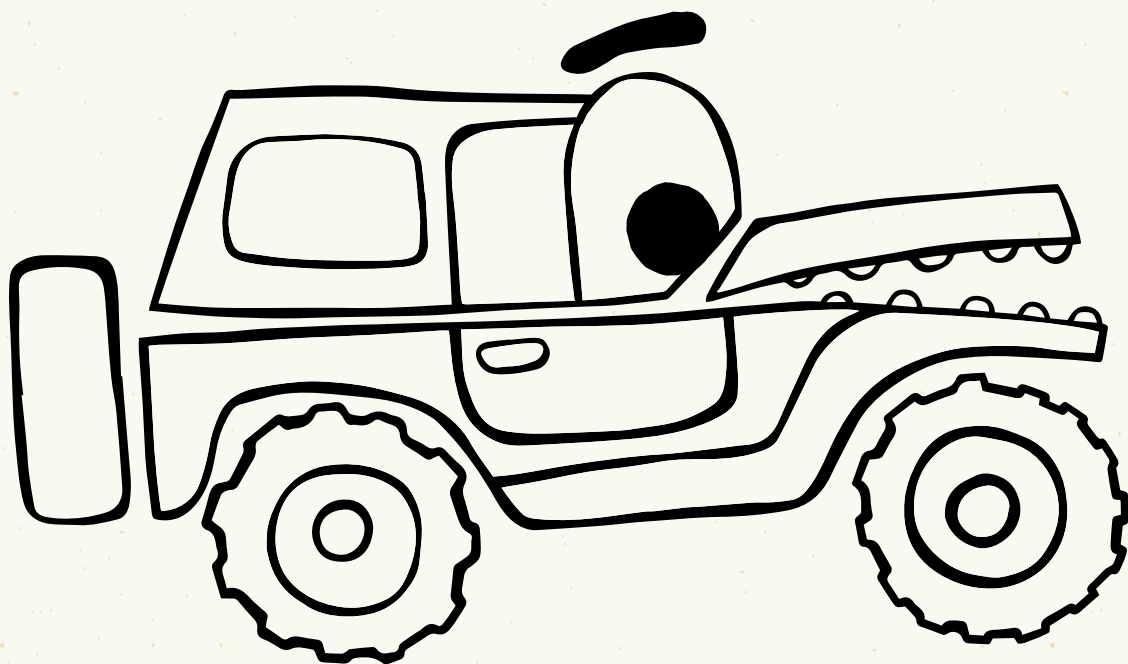

YARN WITH PLATY POLICE

Meet Platy Police — Platy is here to listen to your story. It's Platy Police's job to stop people from making bad choices. Sometimes, police might seem scary, but they are good people whose job is to help keep you safe.

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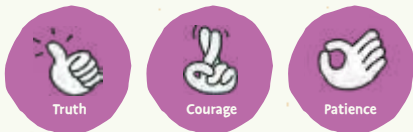

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The main reason you're stopping to yarn with Platypus Police is so they can listen to what happened to you.

They might use a special video camera too so they can remember your story after you keep going on your Big Brave Journey.

This is what you will need to take from Fourbee for your yarn:



Hi, thanks for stopping to yarn with me! You've done nothing wrong — my job is to help you! Did you know that platypus have super sensitive senses that mean we're really good at listening and remembering your story?



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Who is Platy Police? Some Platy Police wear blue, others might wear something different. But all you need to know is that their job is to listen to your story. You don't have to be scared of Platy Police, they're here to listen and help.

Where are we yarning? This stop will happen at the police station so you can tell your story and will be recorded. If you're brave and tell the truth, that's all that matters. This is called 'giving a statement'. Platy Police will have a camera so you can see yourself later on if you need help remembering what you yarned about.

Why are we yarning with Platy Police? Platy Police wants to hear your story so they can help you. After you give your statement, you will watch your video again a bit later on your journey. You will have your PACT Support Person with you then in case you need anything or have any questions.

When will we yarn? Platy Police will talk to you at the start of your Big Brave Journey about what happened to you and what you saw or heard before you go to court to give evidence.

Things to remember when yarning with Platy Police

- 1** Platy is here to help you tell your story, and you're not in trouble
- 2** Your yarn is called a statement and will be recorded by a video camera to watch later
- 3** The only thing you have to do is have courage and be truthful

Thanks for being so brave with your story! If you want to ask any questions, you can ask me or your PACT Support Person when we have our yarn.

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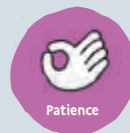
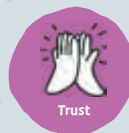
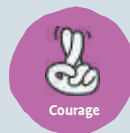
Who is your PACT Support Person? Meeting someone new can take courage and trust. You don't have to worry when meeting your PACT Support Person though, because they're here to help you on your Big Brave Journey.

Where will I see them? They're a real person, but they are a bit like a parrot because they have a big view of your journey. They can fly up to see what's ahead, and let you know what's coming next. You will meet your PACT Support Person at your house or somewhere safe close. You might also meet them at court for the first time.

Why are they here? Your PACT Support Person's job is to make you feel safe, be there for you when you need someone to yarn to, and answer your questions about your Big Brave Journey. Like a parrot, they'll fly in and out to meet you wherever you are on your journey.

How will they help? We don't want you to feel alone on your journey, and your Support Person will be there with you at every stop. They can even help you complete the games in this book!

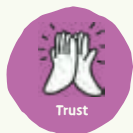
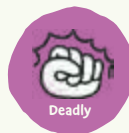
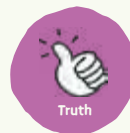
Who am I yarning with? You're yarning with your PACT Support Person so you can feel comfortable about your Big Brave Journey. You'll learn about who they are, the court process, and do activities with them (like drawing).

Where will we yarn? You'll probably be yarning with them at your house, or somewhere safe close to where you live. Because you have met them before (and even if you haven't) you'll remember that they're friendly and here to help you.

What will we yarn about? Anything you want! First, you can ask them what their name is if you don't know it already. You can also yarn about other things like the stops on your Big Brave Journey, where you have to go, the people you will meet, and what you have to do.

Why are we yarning? You're yarning together because your Big Brave Journey is full of new things to look at, places to go, and people to meet. Some of these things need explaining so you understand them, so that's why your PACT Support Person is with you.

Here's what you'll need to bring at Stop 3:



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WHERE TO NEXT?

No two journeys are ever the same. Your journey is unique to you, and there are a number of ways you could go! It might be longer than others, you might take shortcuts, or you might visit the same stops more than once. Wherever you go though, your PACT Support Person will be there to support you.

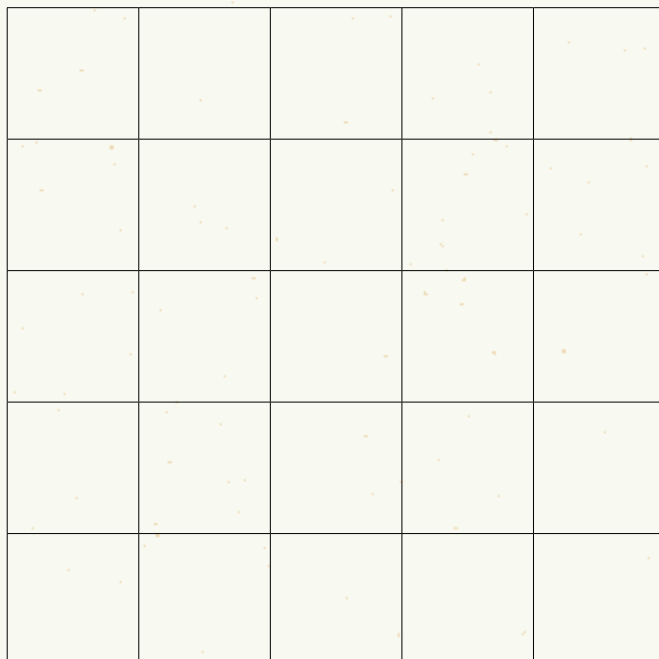
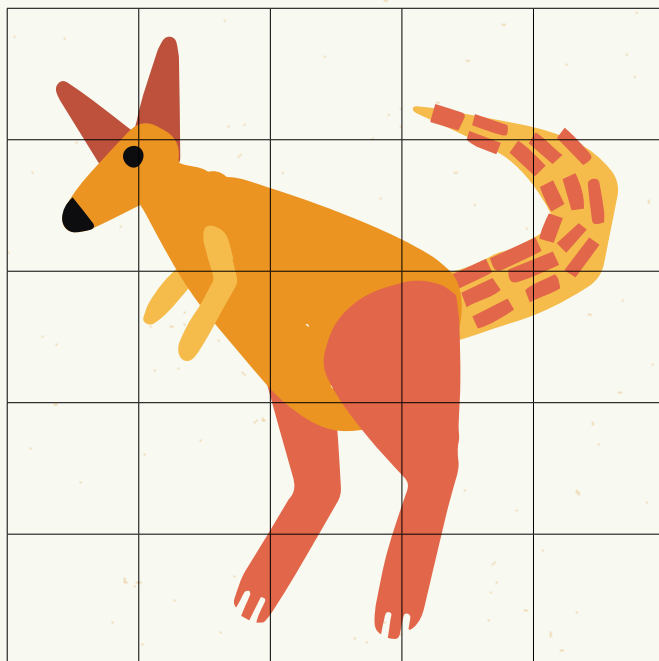

These stops are mainly rooms and buildings in court or close by. You might visit all of these stops, or just some of them. Have a look at the pictures on these pages and see what you can spy.

Waiting areas: There are waiting areas in a court building where you can relax and do some fun activities. You might draw, read books, or just chill out! Your PACT Support Person will be with you here, and in all other rooms within the court building.

Police Station: At the police station, you will talk with Platy Police to tell them your story. Your story might be given as evidence in court if you end up going.



Vulnerable witness room: In this room, you will be able to talk to the judge through a video screen and TV. The judge wants to hear your story — remember, you're not in trouble! The judge just wants to do the right thing.

Prosecutors office: The prosecutor's office is in the court house. You will meet Poss Prosecutor here and yarn with them about your story. It's Poss' job to understand your story so they can talk to the judge about it.



The courtroom is where the judge, bailiff, defence lawyer, prosecutor, defendant, and jury will be for a trial. You won't have to go to a courtroom, but you might talk to them through the video screen and TV from your safe room.

Court building: The court building is where judges, lawyers, prosecutors, and bailiffs, and other people you might meet work. There are a few different rooms and places in the court building you might visit.

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Who is Lizzy Lizard? Lizzy is an Intermediary. Their job is to help people understand each other. She can help you talk to the courts or the police so you understand what they say to you, and so they can understand you. Lizzy works for the court.

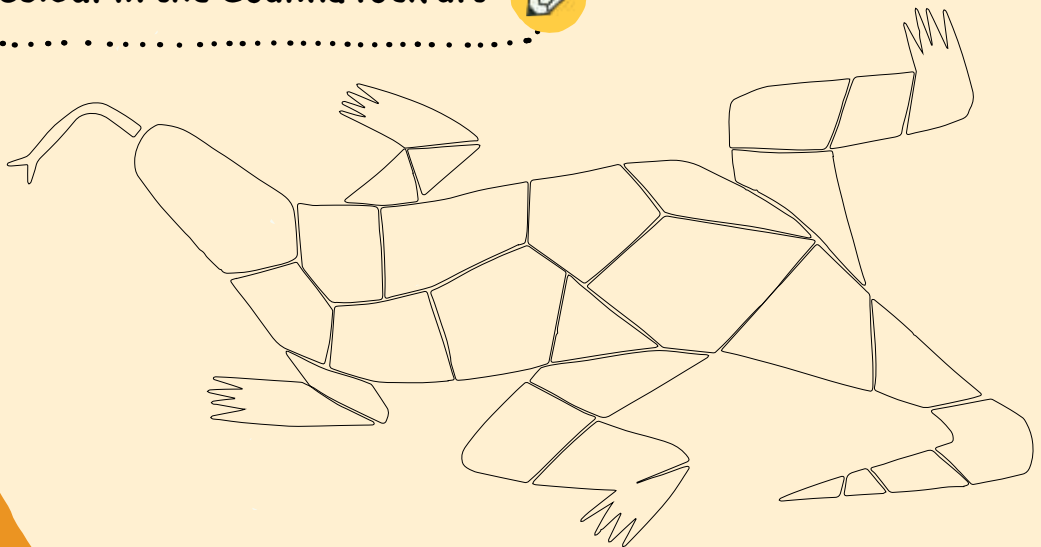
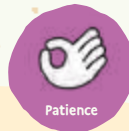
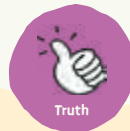
Where will we yarn? You'll meet Lizzy in a special safe room, usually either at the police station, or at the courthouse. There will always be someone else there too, maybe your PACT Support Person, a police officer, or someone from the Office of the Director of Public Prosecution team.

What will we yarn about? Lizzy wants to yarn! You might also do activities or look at books or pictures with Lizzy. If you see Lizzy later in the journey, she'll be working in court and won't be able to yarn then. She'll sit beside you though while you talk in court to help you understand what's happening.

Is Lizzy coming on our road trip? The court decides how often Lizzy gets to see you. If you'd like Lizzy to be there for different parts of your journey, have a yarn with your PACT Support Person about this. And don't worry, Lizzy won't replace them because they have different roles.

WATCH YOUR STORY

At this stop, it's time to watch your story from when you told it to Platy Police. Can you think back to Platy's camera at Stop 1? You'll be in a new place again, and it might feel different — a bit like swimming in a river and looking underneath the water!

If you feel any negative emotions while you watch your story, just let me know because I'll be right there with you.



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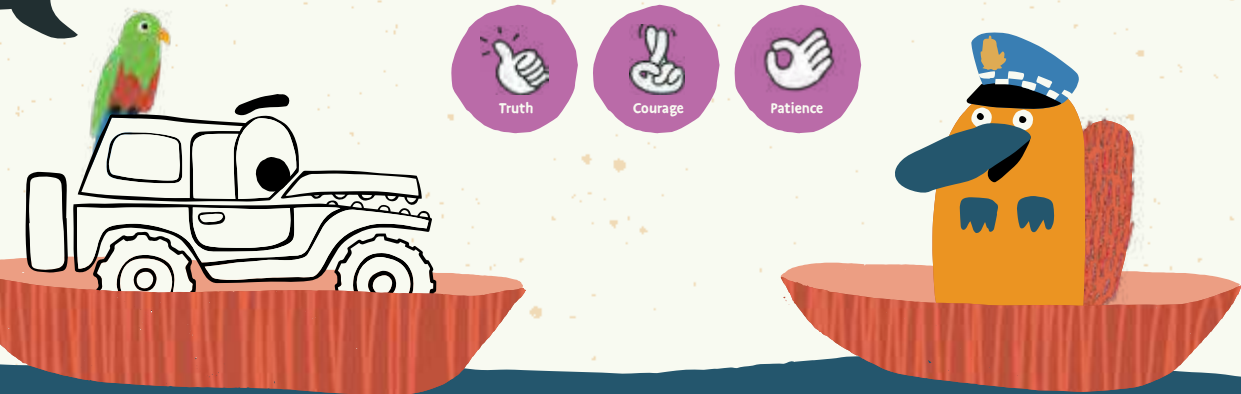
Where will we be? You could be in a special safe room at Poss Prosecutors office, in a police station, or at the courthouse to watch your story. Remember, you're not in trouble and you've done nothing wrong. The reason you're there is because all of the people who support you on your journey work there.

Who will be there? You, Platy Police, Lizzy, PACT Support Person, and there might be a lot of mob there. It might be a while since you last spoke with Platy, so it's okay if you can't remember them or what you said in your story. It's normal to feel all different emotions at this stop, but that's why your PACT Support Person is with you.

What are we going to do? You are going to watch your important story you told to Platy Police. Your PACT Support Person will be with you to help you remember what you said. And if you feel any negative emotions, make sure you let them know.

Why are we watching my story? The more information Platy Police has about your story, the more they can help you. And if there's anything new you need to tell Platy Police about your story, it's important to ask your PACT Support Person to call Poss Prosecutor or Platy Police so that you can tell them what you have remembered.

YARN WITH POSS THE PROSECUTOR

Deadly work, you're past the halfway mark of your Big Brave Journey! This is Poss the Prosecutor. You'll meet Poss at the courthouse, and their job is to help the judge understand what you told Platy Police.

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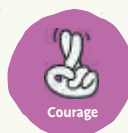
Why am I meeting Poss? Poss' job is to first understand the story you told Platy Police, so they can then tell your story to the judge before the next rest stop. It's important for Poss to make sure that the judge understands your story because the judge might want to ask you some questions about it.

Where are we going? You will meet Poss at the courthouse again, in their office or on a television screen. A lot happens in the courthouse – it's like a big tree in the bush, full of different animals like Poss the Prosecutor doing their jobs and keeping busy.

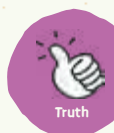
Who will be there with me? You will meet Poss for the first time, but your PACT Support Person will be with you the whole time too. Both Poss and your PACT Support Person want to make sure you feel safe, comfortable and supported because they care about you.

What are we going to do? You might feel nervous, but don't worry – Poss is here to help you and wants to hear your story. They may ask you some questions so they can understand it.

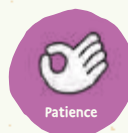

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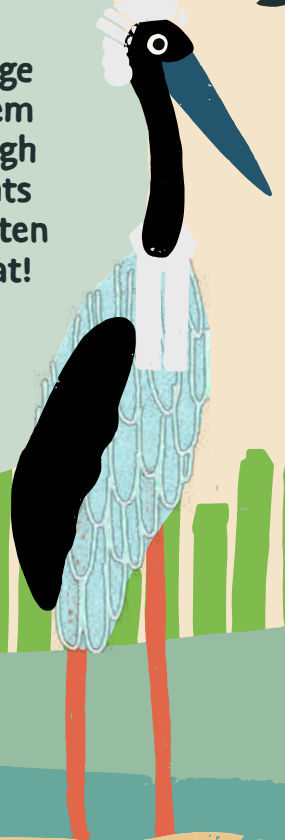

TIME TO GO TO COURT

At this rest stop, you will meet Jabiru Judge in court. But you won't actually meet them in person, you'll be talking to them through a camera and TV screen. Jabiru Judge wants to hear your story too — it's their job to listen and do the right thing. You are doing great!

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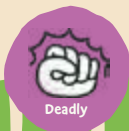
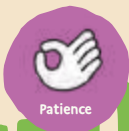
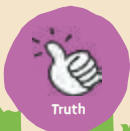
Why am I talking to the Judge? It might not feel good to tell your story again, but Jabiru Judge wants to hear it so they can understand it. They might ask you some questions that you will have to answer – this is called giving evidence. If you have negative emotions, that's okay. Your PACT Support Person will be there to help you.

Where will I be? At the courthouse, you will be in a special safe room with a table, comfy chairs, and a camera with a microphone. When you're in this special safe room, you will be talking to Jabiru Judge through the TV camera and screen. Jabiru Judge will be able to hear you, and you will be able to hear them just like you were talking to them in person.

Who will be there with me? In the special safe room, it will be just you, your PACT Support Person and Lizzy Lizard. Jabiru Judge will be there on the TV screen, but not in the actual safe room with you. When it's over, you can go back to where you live.

What are we going to do? All you have to do in the safe room is listen and talk to Jabiru Judge – remember again that you're not in trouble! Dingo Defence Barrister might ask you some questions too after Poss Prosecutor. You might do this in a safe room you haven't been to before, but it shouldn't take too long and you'll be on your way again soon.

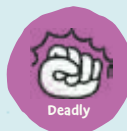
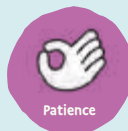
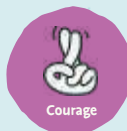
Why are we yarning after court? You might have felt a lot of emotions going to court and talking to Jabiru Judge. Because it's a new experience for you, it can be confusing and different. This is a good time to ask your PACT Support Person any questions if you're unsure about what happened or maybe you just want to talk about how you feel too.

Where will we yarn? You might talk to your PACT Support Person somewhere at court, or where you live. Wherever you are, it's important that you are comfortable and for you to feel like you can yarn about anything for your PACT Support Person.

Who will be with me? At this rest stop, it will just be you and your PACT Support Person. They have been with you for every stop, so hopefully you feel comfortable and safe with them. Because you trust each other, it's easier to ask questions and yarn.

What are we going to yarn about? Now is a great time to ask your PACT Support Person anything you want to know about your Big Brave Journey. It might be why you had to go to court, what Jabiru Judge will do after you spoke to them, or how many more stops are left. They're here just for you, so you can yarn about anything that's on your mind!

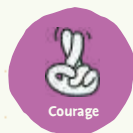

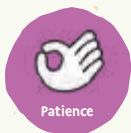

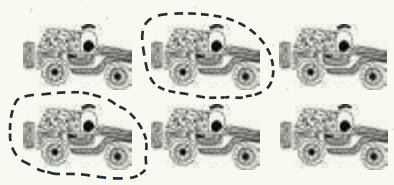
